




Cement Production

China used more cement in the last three years than the U.S. used in the entire 20th century.







- By end 2015, it was clear that China would begin sourcing much of its waters from Russia

- Planners in Lanzhou (central China) drew up proposals to pipe and canal water into the chronically dry region from Siberia's Lake Baikal


Why China's education opportunities matter too
